The Birth Information and Tracing Act 2022 was made a law on 30 June 2022

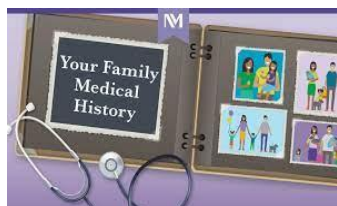


This is for anyone who was adopted, sent to live somewhere else (boarded out) or had their birth illegally registered.



You can now get any information the Irish state has about your birth and early life.

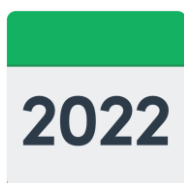
Birth Information and Tracing
